VGrout-7 is recommended for use in all mining, construction or civil applications. This product is not be used a backfill binder.

Setting Times

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


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*Initial set – 4-5 mins

Initial setting time is the time when the paste starts losing its plasticity. Initial set times are important for transportation, placing and compaction of cement concrete.

*Variations are to be expected as a result of changing site conditions, weather, quality of preparation, level of expertise during application & curing. Results from independent core testing.

Application

VGrout-7 must be used as is and not diluted or extended. Additions to the product will change the performance and reduce the efficiency of the product.

Due to the diverse nature and application range of VGrout-7 it is highly recommended grout selection is made by consultation with our trained staff and that on-site training is undertaken prior to the application of the product

VGrout-7 shall be mixed in a high-shear paddle mixer at the required water to powder ratio. The mixer shall be able to accurately measure the required water before the VGrout-7 is slowly added until fully dispersed.

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The product must be used in accordance with strict process and quality control procedures and only be utilised at the discretion of a qualified mining engineer.

Cleaning

All equipment must be cleaned with water immediately after use of VGrout-7 and before set time as per standard practice.

Storage & Shelf Life

If VGrout-7 is kept in its original packaging in a dry environment, shelf life of 6 months is to be expected.

This time may be reduced if the product is subject to high temperatures or humidity. Bulk bags are expected to remain covered in plastic until use. If products are stored underground, they should be stored in a dry area, free from water ingress.

Packaging

VGrout-7 is packaged in 20kg bags, 600kg, 1000kg and 1200kg bulk bags. Other packaging options can be requested.

Health & Safety

- Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear suitable protective clothing.
- Avoid inhalation or ingestion.
- In case of contact with skin or eyes, rinse immediately.
- Seek medical attention immediately if ingested.
